CHURCH HALL REPORT FOR 2023

Two hirers left in 2023 but two were added so regular hirers remained at fourteen. Hire of the hall for meetings, children's parties and social gatherings remained steady throughout the year.

Church use of the hall continued with the Thursday morning communion service, Messy Church, Mothers Union meetings, Sunday morning coffee, charity coffee mornings, choir practice and fundraising events.

Grass and hedge cutting continued to be satisfactorily maintained and with some voluntary help the building and grounds were kept in good order.

Gas appliances were serviced in October and Lindum Fire Services carried out a fire alarm service in May and a fire alarm service and emergency light service in October. One sign emergency light and two emergency spot lights failed during testing. These were duly replaced. The yearly maintenance of the fire equipment also took place in October with no reported issues. Monthly health and safety checks and regular testing of the fire shutters and door were carried out and a fully comprehensive Hall-Guard insurance was maintained.
