Each month we share a simple meal together before invites for the next meeting and services in Church are given out with a goodie bag for the children to take home with them and spread the word to their own friends and families.

Some of the themes and activities that we have created this year include; Trinity the children made discs and magnets showing Father ,Son and Holy Spirit .We talked about the marvel of the Trinity and all the session related to this .
